

Service Commission Options

The options Shape has for generating commission based on the sale of a service package.

Commission Set Up

Functions-> Users-> Add User -> Salesperson

Common Currency or Flat Rate Option

The below will pay out a flat rate of \$50 based on the number of services sold. For example 2 packages sold, \$100 commission generated.




Common Percentage Options

The below will pay out 25% of the package cost and initiation fee all up front.

The below will pay out 50% of the processing fee. For example if the processing fee is \$50 the commission would be \$25. If the fee is discounted at purchase to \$40 the commission would only be \$20.



The below will pay out 50% of the first payment amount (including the initiation fee) only. For example if the init fee is \$50 and the rate is \$100 the commission would be \$75. Any discounts given will affect the commission as well.

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
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Commission Code Options

Commission codes on the services are set with in the type. Navigate to Functions -> Services -> View Types and edit.

For a commission to be generated by code the set up in salesperson set up MUST be set up to be Based on Commission Code. Even if rates and percentages are set in the code area if the Based on isn't set to codes the commission code area will be disregarded.



The below will pay out a percentage of either the Processing Fee or First Payment made, depending on the Service purchased.



The below will pay out a flat rate based on the type of service sold.



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Leveling Options

Leveling allows you to increase the amount of commission paid as the amount of sales go up over a year. Leveling and commission codes cannot be used in conjunction.

The set up below will initially pay the salesperson 10% of the first payment amount on each service package sold. When their total sales hit \$20,000 the commission percentage will go up to 15% for all sales until the next level is reached. The count begins again on January of the next year.



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
